Use this PDF to organize chargers, adapters, power banks, SIM/eSIM, offline maps, document backups, app access, photo storage, and lost-phone recovery.

#### 1 Map your devices

List phone, charger, adapter, power bank, camera, laptop, cables, and wearables.

#### 2 Create offline

Save documents, maps, bookings, emergency contacts, and screenshots.

#### 3 Secure access

Use passcode, backup codes, cloud sync, and payment safety settings.

#### 4 Prepare recovery

Know what to do if phone, cards, or laptop are lost or stolen.

### Official reminder

Passport, visa, transit, health, medicine, airline baggage, payment, and local safety rules can change. Always verify important details with official government, airline, embassy, airport, and health sources before travel.



## Device readiness matrix

Prepare every device by purpose, power, and backup.

Device/item	Why it matters	Before travel
<b>Phone</b>	Maps, tickets, money, camera, communication.	Update, charge, backup, enable passcode.
<b>Power bank</b>	Keeps phone alive during long days.	Check airline limits and carry-on rules.
<b>Adapter</b>	Needed for charging in destination plugs.	Confirm plug type and voltage needs.
<b>Chargers/cables</b>	Small missing cable can break the system.	Pack primary + backup cable.
<b>Laptop/tablet</b>	Work, entertainment, documents.	Encrypt, backup, protect in carry-on.
<b>Headphones</b>	Flights, calls, translation, quiet time.	Charge and pack cable if needed.

**Tech rule: pack the charging chain, not only the device. Device + cable + plug + adapter + backup power.**



# Tech preparation timeline

A calmer way to prepare digital travel essentials.

1

## 14 days before

Check passport/visa copies, app logins, cloud backup, storage space, and adapter needs.

2

## 7 days before

Download offline maps, translation packs, bookings, and important PDFs.

3

## 48 hours before

Charge power bank, update apps, screenshot tickets, and test eSIM/SIM plan if possible.

4

## Departure day

Keep phone, power bank, documents, charger, and headphones in personal item.

5

## During trip

Back up photos regularly and avoid entering passwords on public devices.

6

## Before return

Check storage, backup memories, and keep boarding documents offline.



## Tech travel red flags

Small tech mistakes create big travel stress.

### ONLY ONE CHARGER

- A lost cable can stop maps and boarding passes.
- Carry one backup cable.

### NO OFFLINE MAPS

- Airport data and roaming can fail.
- Download city and hotel area maps.

### FULL STORAGE

- Photos and videos fail at the best moment.
- Free space before travel.

### PUBLIC WI-FI LOGIN

- Be careful with banking or sensitive logins.
- Use safer networks and app protections.

### LOW BATTERY HABIT

- Navigation drains faster while traveling.
- Charge whenever you can.

### NO BACKUP CODES

- Two-factor login can block access abroad.
- Save recovery methods securely.

### WRONG ADAPTER

- Plug shape and voltage matter.
- Check destination before packing.

### NO PHONE LOSS PLAN

- Lost phone can mean lost bookings and payments.
- Prepare recovery contacts and backups.

**Avoid storing sensitive documents unprotected. Use secure storage and keep printed backups for critical travel documents.**



## Power and plug decision board

Know how you will keep devices alive.

Power need	Common issue	Practical fix
<b>Long flight</b>	Phone and headphones may drain.	Charge fully and pack cable in personal item.
<b>Long sightseeing day</b>	Maps and camera use heavy battery.	Carry charged power bank.
<b>Multiple devices</b>	Too few outlets or cables.	Use compact multi-port charger.
<b>Different plug type</b>	Adapter missing or wrong.	Check destination plug before packing.
<b>Hotel outlet location</b>	Outlet may be far from bed.	Pack longer cable if useful.
<b>Airport charging</b>	Public outlets can be busy or slow.	Charge early and do not rely on last minute.

**Carry power banks in cabin baggage and always check current airline and security rules for batteries.**



## Lost phone response cards

Prepare a calm recovery sequence before panic starts.

### FIRST 10 MINUTES

- Use find-my-device if available.
- Call or message phone if safe.

### SECURE ACCOUNTS

- Lock phone, payment apps, email, and cards if needed.
- Use backup device or trusted support.

### RECOVER DOCUMENTS

- Use printed copies and offline folder.
- Contact airline/hotel with booking references.

### REPORT LOSS

- Report theft/loss where useful for insurance.
- Keep report and claim details.

### Extra checks to complete

- Save one screenshot or note for this topic before leaving home.
- Confirm the related booking, rule, cost, or document using an official or trusted source.
- Write one backup option in case your first plan fails.
- Keep the most important detail available offline on your phone.
- Review this page again during the final 48 hours before departure.
- Use Voyasee.com tools to double-check budget, documents, packing, and safety.

### Practical field note

Your phone is important, but your travel should not depend on one unlocked device with no backups.



## Internet setup timeline

Get connected without rushing into bad decisions.

1

### Before travel

Compare roaming, eSIM, local SIM, and Wi-Fi needs for your destination.

2

### At airport

Use official stores/kiosks and check total price, data, validity, and ID requirements.

3

### Before leaving kiosk

Test data, calls if needed, hotspot, and app access.

4

### At hotel

Save Wi-Fi details, check connection, and download maps for tomorrow.

5

### During trip

Use trusted networks and avoid sensitive logins on unknown devices.

6

### Before return

Cancel temporary plans or remove eSIM if needed after trip.

# Photo and storage safety board

Protect your travel memories and storage space.

Need	Risk	Better habit
<b>Storage space</b>	Phone fills during trip.	Free space before departure.
<b>Cloud backup</b>	Photos lost if phone breaks.	Back up on hotel Wi-Fi.
<b>Battery use</b>	Camera drains phone fast.	Carry power bank and manage screen brightness.
<b>Sensitive photos</b>	Passport and cards in gallery can be risky.	Use secure storage, not public gallery.
<b>Camera gear</b>	Theft or damage risk.	Keep valuables discreet and insured if needed.
<b>Memory cards</b>	Card can fail or be lost.	Rotate backups and keep separate.

**Separate beautiful memories from sensitive documents. Both need backup, but not the same visibility.**



## Digital safety habits

Simple habits reduce stress and scams.

### PAYMENT SAFETY

- Use alerts and lock cards when suspicious.
- Avoid saving card details everywhere.

### QR CAUTION

- Check QR links before paying or downloading.
- Be careful with fake menus or parking links.

### DEVICE PRIVACY

- Use screen lock and do not leave phone at tables.
- Hide sensitive notifications.

### SHARED COMPUTERS

- Avoid banking or email on public devices.
- Log out and clear traces if unavoidable.
